Cost

Prices for overnight accommodations at the hostel vary slightly by season, ranging between \$22-\$31 per person, per night. Please contact us for details on pricing and availability for the dates you would like to stay. Price includes make-it-yourself pancake breakfasts, linens, towels, and blankets.

Itinerary Planning

During your stay at the hostel, we offer several options for your troop to make the most of your stay. The following activities are available for no additional cost:

- "World Travel 101" - A one-hour workshop on how to travel safely, responsibly, and in a culturally sensitive way
- "Passport to Adventure" - A hands-on activity that helps girls meet international travelers at the hostel, and learn about their culture

- Community Service Opportunities- Work with local non-profit organizations to help people in our community and the environment

Other optional activities include:

- Round trip ferry ticket to Coronado (\$6 per person)
- Bike Rentals (\$10 per person, from Downtown location)
- Day Tripper- All day transportation pass for bus and trolley (\$5 per person)
